Classes:

Minor Puppy Class:	4-6 months
Puppy Class:	6-9 months
Junior Class:	9-18 months
Intermediate Class:	15-24 months
Open Class:	from 15 months
Working Class:	from 15 months (it is necessary to provide FCI certificate that entitles the dog to enter the working class)
Champion Class:	from 15 months, available for dogs with recognized international or national champion title, National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of the Specialty Dog Show, European Winner, World Winner. The titles must be obtained in adult class.
Veteran Class:	older than 8 years
Honour Class:	from 15 months, available for dogs with accepted international or national champion title, National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of the Specialty Dog Show, European Winner, World Winner, without the right to CAC title. Dogs will receive grades and ranking. Excellent 1 will participate in the competition for BOB, BOS.

Applications missing the **copy of proof of payment and both sides of the copy of FCI pedigree** will not be accepted.

The exhibition is opened to males and females registered in FCI recognized breed studbooks. When registering a dog into a specific class, the age of the dog on the day of the exhibition is determinative.

If the copies of the documents proving that the dog is entitled to be shown in the working or champion class are not presented, the dog will get reassigned to the open class.

Titles to be awarded during breed judging:

CAJC, CAC, res.CAC, Specialty Winner, BOB, BOS, BOJ, BOV

Titles to be awarded during the final competitions:

Best Couple
Best Breeding Group
Junior Best in Show
Best Veteran
Best in Show

Note: It is not compulsory to award titles. Titles may be awarded regardless of the number of showed dogs. Ranking of the first four dogs awarded excellent or very good (resp. very promising or promising) will be determined in each class.

Documents necessary for attending the show: Entry confirmation, FCI Pedigree, Pet Passport

Veterinary conditions:

All dogs involved must be clinically healthy.

All dogs involved must be immune to rabies.

Dogs coming from the Czech Republic must be accompanied by a valid vaccination card (according to §6 of the Veterinary Law) or by a valid passport for small animals.

Dogs from the EU and third countries must meet the conditions set out in Regulation (EC) No. 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003.

General provisions:

The exhibition organizer is not responsible for any damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor nor for the death or loss of a dog. Dogs are not allowed to run off leash at the exhibition ground. Bitches in heat, bitches in the second half of gravidity, lactating bitches and dogs with surgical or other veterinary intervention eliminating any exterior imperfection will be excluded from the show. The show is held according to the FCI and ČMKU Regulations for Dog Shows. If the exhibition cannot take place for objective reasons (veterinary measures, natural disaster etc.), the fees shall be fully or partially used to cover the costs of the exhibition. **This measure applies also if the exhibition is cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemics.**

Exhibitors take full responsibility for the correctness of the data stated in the application. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for possible mistakes in the catalogue caused by bad readability of the application.

An incorrect registration of a dog in a class must be announced by the exhibitor to the organizer of the show not later than before the start of judging in the ring.

By submitting the application, the exhibitor gives consent with stating their name, surname, and address in the exhibition catalogue as well as in the results summary of the exhibition.

Protests:

A protest against a judge's decision is inadmissible. Protests may only be submitted for formal reasons in case of violating the regulations. The protest must be filed in writing, together with the principal deposit of 90,-EUR, before the judging is finished, to the hands of the protest committee. If the protest is not recognized as justified, the principal will be forfeited in favour of the organizer of the exhibition.

ORGANIZER RESERVES THE RIGHT FOR CHANGES.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE DOG FOR THE EXHIBITION WILL BE CONFIRMED ONE WEEK BEFORE THE EXHIBITION BY SENDING THE ENTRY CONFIRMATION.
